#### 4. Segment Monitoring Using Adva OTDR Hardware at each node

At the August C3 Operations Committee Meeting, a suggestion was made to consider implementation of ADVA monitoring hardware at each node, which would allow rapid OTDR readings to determine the location of a fiber fault.

Chelo Picardal/Mark Strand

- Initial budgetary estimates place the cost for this hardware at \$80,000, 40 hours of UW labor (\$5-7K), plus additions to Ring Lifecycle costs, and annual maintenance.
- Considerations for discussion include:
  - Costs (especially in light of lower revenues)
  - Impact to current PA 70 SLA
  - Possible changes to UW NOC processes in the event of an alert/advisory
